



VISITOR INFORMATION & EXPECTATIONS

Welcome! Columbia Memorial Hospital (CMH) and CMH Medical Group caregivers are doing everything they can to keep you safe, but we need your help.

General guidelines for your safety

While at any CMH location, please:



Stay at least 6-feet away from people you do not live with.



Wear a cloth, paper or disposable face covering at all times while indoors. A face covering helps prevent the spread of viruses. See the flipside.



Avoid touching your face or mask. If you do touch your face or mask, wash or sanitize your hands right away, before touching anything else.



Cover coughs and sneezes with your elbow or a tissue. If you use a tissue, throw the tissue away and wash or sanitize your hands right away.



Request that your temperature be checked at any time at a CMH Screening or Nursing Station.

Visiting a patient in the hospital

When visiting a patient in the hospital, please:

Limit Visitors: Follow the hospital's limits on the number of guests a patient may have during a single visit. Visitors must be 12 or older.

Social Distance: Stay 6-feet away from people you do not live with, when using common areas, including waiting rooms.

Wear a Mask: You must wear a mask at all times, even when you are with a patient who is a member of your household. See the flipside.

Eat or Drink Carefully: Do not eat or drink in a patient's room, unless they are a member of your household. You may purchase food from the cafeteria and sit outside or in your vehicle to eat. Only staff are allowed to eat in the cafeteria at this time.

Use Assistive Technology: Ask the nursing staff about setting up a group Skype or phone call. CMH has dedicated iPads or tablets for this use.
